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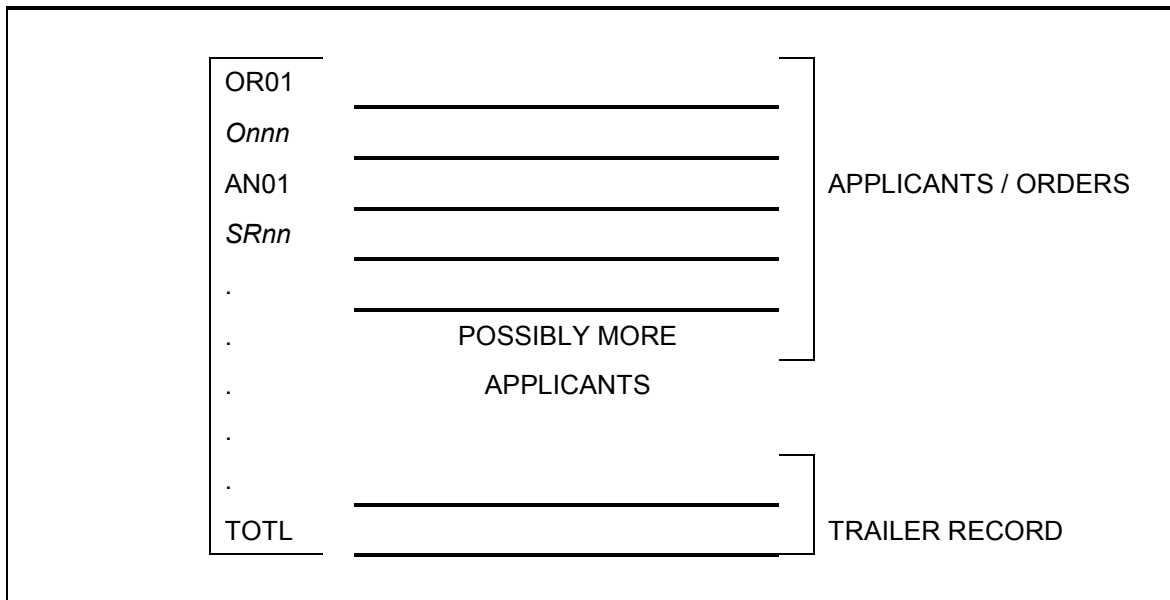
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File Specifications

A service request file contains one or more applicants. Each applicant represents one or more service requests. **Each applicant has a minimum of three 132-byte records generated. Each record is delimited with the default new line sequence (either 1 or 2 characters) of the hosting system.** The maximum number of records depends on the number of services requested for that applicant. The first four characters of each record indicate the record type. For a representation of a file, see **Figure 1** below.

Quoteback Rules

1. **Sender Quoteback** - Identifies the order ID generated and used by the *sending* system to track the order. When an order or message is forwarded from one system to the next it is replaced with the unique ID generated by the sender's system (client, ExamOne hub, service provider). In the creation of an OR01 order, the client's unique quoteback number goes in the Sender Quoteback field.
2. **Client Quoteback** - Empty in initial OR01 order. When a message is forwarded internally from one system to the next, the client's unique quoteback in the Sender Quoteback field is replaced with the "new" sender's own unique ID. To preserve the client's unique quoteback, it is moved to the Client Quoteback field.
3. **Receiver Quoteback** - This stores the unique quoteback generated by, and known to, the system that is to receive the message. It is primarily used to identify the order to a system that has already seen it once and has a record of it associated with a unique ID created by that system. In an initial OR01 order, it is blank since the receiving system has never seen the order before. When a client receives a status file back on an order, the client's unique quoteback will be found in the Receiver Quoteback field.

NOTE: It is important for the client to make note of/store the Sender Quoteback found in confirmation or status files, as that is the unique ID for the order generated by the ExamOne system and used internally to track the order. That Sender Quoteback must be referenced back in the Receiver Quoteback field on any electronic orders for additional services (excluding labs) for that applicant.

4. **Adding services to existing orders (non-lab)** - As mentioned in the note above, add-on service requests may be sent for any orders already submitted as long as the original order has not been billed. For add-on orders other than labs, the OR01 add-on order must identify the previous order thru:
 - Receiver Quoteback field - return the unique ID found in Sender Quoteback field of the confirmation or status file from the original order

- Sender Quoteback field - return the same client unique quoteback number sent in the Sender Quoteback of the original order
5. **Lab Add-On Orders** - Because these orders go directly to the lab the quoteback numbers are of little benefit. The applicant's original record will be pulled up in the lab system by lab customer service (typically by demographic information, name/SSN, ticket number etc.) and the add-on tests ordered. The mechanism to insert the quoteback into the lab system only occurs at the origination of the lab record for that applicant, so any new quotebacks generated and sent with lab add-on test orders will not get into the lab system. This also means that the client quoteback referenced in the set of raw data lab results generated from an add-on test will be the same original quoteback that appeared in the initial lab results.
